despite the enormous amount of writing devoted to the Beatles during the last few decades the band's abiding intellectual and cultural significance has received scant attention using various modes of literary musicological and cultural criticism the essays in *Reading the Beatles* firmly establish the Beatles as a locus of serious academic and cultural study exploring the group's resounding impact on how we think about gender popular culture and the formal and poetic qualities of music the contributors trace not only the literary and musicological qualities of selected Beatles songs but also the development of the Beatles' artistry in their films and the ways in which the band has functioned as a cultural historical and economic product in a poignant afterword Jane Tompkins offers an autobiographical account of the ways in which the Beatles afforded her with the self-actualizing means to become less alienated from popular culture gender expectations and even herself during the early 1960s

addresses the band's resounding impact on how we think about gender popular culture and the formal and poetic qualities of music

an all access firsthand account of the life and music of one of history's most beloved bands from an original mastering engineer at abbey road geoff emerick became an assistant engineer at the legendary abbey road studios in 1962 at age fifteen and was

present as a new band called the beatles recorded their first songs he later worked with the beatles as they recorded their singles she loves you and i want to hold your hand the songs that would propel them to international superstardom in 1964 he would witness the transformation of this young and playful group from liverpool into professional polished musicians as they put to tape classic songs such as eight days a week and i feel fine then in 1966 at age nineteen geoff emerick became the beatles chief engineer the man responsible for their distinctive sound as they recorded the classic album revolver in which they pioneered innovative recording techniques that changed the course of rock history emerick would also engineer the monumental sgt pepper and abbey road albums considered by many the greatest rock recordings of all time in here there and everywhere he reveals the creative process of the band in the studio and describes how he achieved the sounds on their most famous songs emerick also brings to light the personal dynamics of the band from the relentless and increasingly mean spirited competition between lennon and mccartney to the infighting and frustration that eventually brought a bitter end to the greatest rock band the world has ever known

a legendary record producer and performer takes readers on an alphabetical journey of insights into the music of the beatles and individual reminiscences of john paul george and ringo peter asher met the beatles in the spring of 1963 the start of a lifelong association with the band and its members he had a front row seat as they elevated pop music into an art form and he was present at the creation of some of the most iconic music of our times asher is also a talented musician in his own right with a great ear for what was new and fresh once when paul mccartney wrote a song that john lennon didn't think was right for the beatles asher asked if he could record it a world without love became a global no 1 hit for his duo peter gordon a few years later asher was asked by paul mccartney to help start apple records the first artist asher discovered and signed up was a young american singer songwriter named james taylor before long he would be not only managing and producing taylor but also having left apple and moved to los angeles working with linda ronstadt neil diamond robin williams joni mitchell and cher among others the beatles from a to zed grows out of his popular radio program from me to you on siriusxm's the beatles channel where he shares memories and insights about the fab four and their music here he weaves his reflections into a whimsical alphabetical journey that focuses not only on songs whose titles start with each letter but also on recurrent themes

in the beatles music the instruments they played the innovations they pioneered the artists who influenced them the key people in their lives and the cultural events of the time few can match peter asher for his fresh and personal perspective on the beatles and no one is a more congenial and entertaining guide to their music

book the beatles sixth studio album rubber soul was a game changer by december 1965 when the album was released the beatles had played the first arena rock show at shea stadium for 55 000 delirious fans been awarded mbe member of british empire medals and were indisputably the greatest musical phenomenon since elvis presley with their first film a hard day s night john paul george and ringo laid down the blueprint for everyone who ever wanted to form a group the movie entertaining as it was became an instruction manual for aspiring pop stars of the day on how to play dress and act richard lester s 1964 comedy turned out to be the touchstone for every music video that followed then with the release of rubber soul the beatles created an artistic benchmark to which their peers measured their craft and creativity touring the world over two years the band had grown up fast both musically and lyrically their new album represented a major leap upon hearing rubber soul bob dylan allegedly remarked i get it you re not cute anymore newsweek hailed the beatles as the bards of pop while critic greil marcus claimed rubber soul was the best album they would ever make for traffic s steve winwood the album broke everything open it crossed music into a whole new dimension and was responsible for kicking off the sixties rock era in this bird has flown john kruth not only analyzes the songs and making of rubber soul putting the album in context of the turbulent times in which it was created but captures the spirit of musical innovation and poetry that makes the record a standout in the beatle s canon

acquired wisdom has always put sgt pepper at the head of the class but it was revolver that truly signaled the beatles sea change from a functional band to a studio based ensemble these changes began before rubber soul but came to fruition on revolver which took an astonishing 300 hours to produce far more than any rock record before it the making of revolver hunkered down in abbey road with george martin is in itself a great beatles story but would be nothing if the results weren't so impactful more than even sgt pepper and pet sounds revolver fed directly into the rock n roll zeitgeist and its influence could be heard everywhere from the psychedelic san francisco sound jefferson airplane grateful dead to the first wave of post blues hard rock sabbath zeppelin through movie soundtracks and pretty much everything that followed it including every generation of guitar based pop

music and even heavy metal more than any record before or after revolver was the game changer and this is finally the detailed telling of its storied recording and enormous impact in little under a decade four young men from liverpool became more than anyone could have predicted the beatles provided the soundtrack for the swinging sixties wrote and recorded groundbreaking albums made films and had fans around the world featuring intimate photographs familiar publicity shots and a lively account of their career from the band s early days to their break up this book looks back at the story that is the beatles alongside the year by year and album by album descriptions there are also comprehensive guides to their singles and movies as well as a whole host of surprising facts the beatles is a worthy tribute to one of the greatest bands of all time

a detailed look at every piece of studio gear used full explanations of effects and recording processes and an inside look at how specific songs were recorded

these 56 essays excerpts short stories and poems collected and reprinted by the three poet editors from diverse sources reflect how their authors music critic greil marcus poets david wojan and donald hall early beatle stuart sutcliffe and many others have loved and internalized the beatles and their music in his poem portland coliseum allen ginsberg for example exultantly recounts attending an early beatles concert indeed the beatles very public february 9 1964 appearance on the ed sullivan show comes up again and again in these pages as a sort of mantra for a generation s coming of age though leonard bernstein writes of how the four mop-tops overwhelmed a 46 year old conductor on that winter night not all of the writers flatter the band witness larry neal s attempt to explain the beatles failure to capture the hearts of some african americans or eric gamalinda s wonderful yarn about the band s disastrous trip to the philippines for sheer fun and creativity timothy leary s essay thank god for the beatles alone justifies the price of admission john lennon george harrison paul mccartney and ringo starr are mutants revolutionary agents sent by god endowed by mysterious powers to create a new human species yeah yeah yeah

the truth about the music myths and madness of the beatles era from the only four people who knew the answers

all you need is love but tell that to the blue meanies if they have their way it will mean the end of music but they haven t counted on young fred he climbs aboard the yellow submarine and journeys to liverpool where he finds four fab musicians who might just be able to help

here is the beatles story as it really was throw away what you think you know and start afresh

a true adventure coming of age tale set in the exhilarating first wave of beatlemania in 1964 16 year old janice escapes a grim foster home in cleveland by running away to london to meet the beatles and unwittingly becomes international news looks back at an era when young women exercising control in their lives threatened adult society

a real breakthrough in terms of applying a theoretical protocol to biographical material has come with henry w sullivan s unpromisingly titled the beatles with lacan rock n roll as requiem for the modern age sullivan provides an excellent analysis of the beatles career

perhaps along with ian macdonald's revolution in the head fourth estate 1994 the best so far available but in using the work of lacan sullivan offers a psychoanalytic framework to discuss personality and creativity he also provides a provocative analysis of the roots of rock n roll arguing that the paternal guard of the time born in the first two decades of the twentieth century were traumatized on a subconscious level by the mistakes of their parents and in losing respect for them turned a blind eye to and as a result tacitly supported the flaunting of moral codes by their own sons and daughters in the 1950s and 1960s without having been placed under any real obligation to do so p 13 it is out of this that the beatles individual biographies are discussed furthermore sullivan argues that what gives the beatles and their music their real distinction is their location temporally between the modern and the postmodern world views the albums between rubber soul in 1965 and abbey road in 1969 constitute the first popular post modern classic p 172 this is an innovative though never obtuse piece of writing and stands as the first real attempt to theorize the beatles life and work the year's work in critical and cultural theory covering the year 1995 vol 5 section 14 pp 196-97 by the young british film score composer david buckley

ken mcNab's in depth look at the beatles acrimonious final year is a detailed account of the breakup featuring the perspectives of all four band members and their roles a must to add to the collection of beatles fans and in the end is full of fascinating information available for the first time mcNab reconstructs for the first time the seismic events of 1969 when the beatles reached new highs of creativity and new lows of the internal strife that would destroy them between the pressure of being filmed during rehearsals and writing sessions for the documentary get back their company apple corps facing bankruptcy lennon's heroin use and musical disagreements the group was arguing more than ever before and their formerly close friendship began to disintegrate in the midst of this rancour however emerged the disharmony of let it be and the ragged genius of abbey road their incredible farewell love letter to the world

surveying concerts interviews films music outtakes and bootlegs mckinney employs the insights of history aesthetics sociology psychology and mythology to account for the the beatles impact his book is also an appreciation of the group's artistry exploring their music as timeless expression and visceral response to an historical moment

a must have volume for all beatles fans a career spanning selection of writings about the fab four there are of course many books on the beatles but this is the only one available that is a comprehensive career spanning collection of journalism about the legendary band before and after the breakup consisting of more than fifty articles essays interviews record and movie reviews poems and book excerpts many of them rare and hard to find read the beatles is an unprecedented compilation that follows the arc of the fab four s iconic and idiosyncratic career from their early days in liverpool through their tragic and triumphant histories after the group s split the book also includes original essays from noted musicians and journalists about the beatles lasting influence and why they still matter today
