the first survey of the classic twentieth century houses that defined american midwestern modernism famed as the birthplace of that icon of twentieth century architecture the skyscraper chicago also cultivated a more humble but no less consequential form of modernism the private residence modern in the middle chicago houses 1929 75 explores the substantial yet overlooked role that chicago and its suburbs played in the development of the modern single family house in the twentieth century in a city often associated with the outsize reputations of frank lloyd wright and ludwig mies van der rohe the examples discussed in this generously illustrated book expand and enrich the story of the region s built environment authors susan benjamin and michelangelo sabatino survey dozens of influential houses by architects whose contributions are ripe for reappraisal such as paul

schweikher harry weese keck keck and william pereira from the bold early example of the battledeck house by henry dubin 1930 to john vinci and lawrence kenny s gem the freeark house 1975 the generation spanning residences discussed here reveal how these architects contended with climate and natural setting while negotiating the dominant influences of wright and mies they also reveal how residential clients typically middle class professionals progressive in their thinking helped to trailblaze modern architecture in america though reflecting different approaches to site space structure and materials the examples in modern in the middle reveal an abundance of astonishing houses that have never been collected into one study until now

today the museum of modern art is widely recognized for establishing the canon of modern art yet in its early years the museum considered modern art part of a still unfolding experiment in contemporary visual production by bracketing moma s early history from its later reputation this book explores the ways the museum acted as a laboratory to set an ambitious agenda for the exhibition of a multidisciplinary idea of modern art between its founding in 1929 and its 20th anniversary in 1949 moma created the first museum departments of architecture and design film and photography in the country marshaled modern art as a political tool and brought consumer culture into a versatile yet institutional context encompassing 14 essays that investigate the diversity of modern art this volume demonstrates how moma s programming shaped a version of modern art that was not elitist but fundamentally intertwined with all levels of cultural production

google records where we go online and how we set our thermostats facebook changes our privacy settings when it wishes target gets hacked and loses control of our credit card information our medical records are available for sale to strangers our children are fingerprinted and their every test score saved for posterity and small robots patrol our schoolyards and drones may soon fill our skies the contributors to this anthology don't simply describe these problems or warn about the loss of privacy they propose solutions they look closely at business practices public policy and technology design and ask should this continue is there a better approach they take seriously the dictum of thomas edison what one creates with his hand he should control with his head it's a new approach to the privacy debate one that assumes privacy is worth protecting that there are solutions to be found and that the future is not yet known this volume will be an essential reference for policy makers and researchers journalists and scholars and others looking for answers to one of the biggest challenges of our modern day the premise is clear there's a problem let's find a solution

philosopher sociologist and urban theorist henri lefebvre 1901 1991 was one of the great social theorists of the twentieth century and pioneered the theorization of everyday life and space in this fascinating book which became a manifesto for urban activism upon its first publication in the 1960s lefebvre poses a major question what gives a society undergoing constant change the illusion of stability for lefebvre the answer is that our everyday lives are the product of decisions from which we are alienated resulting in what he memorably describes as terror enforced passivity modern capitalism produces and controls the space around us the buildings we work in the roads we drive on and even the parks surrounding us are artificial and controlled isolating the individual in a life of repetition lefebvre rejects such a world of control and monotony urging instead a spontaneous utopian creativity in which human beings can engage in meaningful work and leisure profound and prophetic for its insights into the impact of capitalism and urbanization everyday life in the modern world remains a classic work by a towering thinker and essential reading today this routledge classics edition includes a new foreword by claire revol and rob shields

many argue that the modern family is an anachronistic institution whose demise is only a question of time looking to the family s future the eminent sociologist brigitte berger argues that despite being weakened and embattled the family will survive as a fundamental social institution the family has been the cradle of the modern social order for some three hundred years and will remain the basis for any society concerned with happiness liberty equality and prosperity for all its members rather than being condemned to the dust heap of history or becoming a simple lifestyle choice the modern family has a number of enduring strengths that will ensure its survival in the family in the modern age berger focuses on four major areas of concern first she demonstrates that the short shrift given to the institutional dimension of the family misrepresents the importance and the role of the family today second she documents the close cognitive fit between core elements of

the modern family and the stability of modern society and argues that any society that ignores this connection does so at its own peril third berger investigates the degree to which currently identified problems may endanger the modern family s vital individual and social functions and finally she develops reasonable projections of the future of the family that will be core elements contributing to the creation of a politically democratic and economically prosperous world berger takes a long range view of the career of the conventional family in the twentieth century her perspective is distinctly different from that widespread in scholarly literature today she takes account of recent demographic shifts in behavior relating to sexuality marriage family structure and values relationships and family functions berger considers hotly contested contemporary issues relating to the family gay marriage divorce abortion women and work issues of child care among others bu
