2. The Specific Case of \log_2

Our focus is \log_2 . Here, the base (x) is 2, and the argument (y) is also 2. We're essentially asking: "To what power must we raise 2 to get 2?" The answer is intuitively obvious: 2 raised to the power of 1 equals 2 ($2^1 = 2$). Therefore, $\log_2 2 = 1$.

3. Visualizing with Exponential Curves

Consider the graph of the exponential function $y = 2^x$. This graph shows the relationship between x (the exponent) and y (the result of 2 raised to the power of x). This implies $x = 2^2 = 4$.
