smith s powerful style of living journalism uses the collective cathartic nature of the theater to move us from despair toward hope the village voice anna deavere smith s extraordinary form of documentary theater shines a light on injustices by portraying the real life people who have experienced them one of her most ambitious and powerful works on how matters of race continue to divide and enslave the nation variety smith renders a host of figures who have lived and fought the system that pushes students of color out of the classroom and into prisons as smith has put it rich kids get mischief poor kids get pathologized and incarcerated using people s own words culled from interviews and speeches smith depicts rev jamal harrison bryant who eulogized freddie gray niya kenny a high school student who confronted a violent police deputy activist bree newsome who took the confederate flag down from the south carolina state house grounds and many others their voices bear powerful witness to a great iniquity of our time and call us to action with their accounts of resistance and hope

field life examines the practice of science in the field in the great plains and rocky mountains of the american west between the 1860s and the 1910s when the railroad was the dominant form of long distance transportation grounded in approaches from environmental history and the history of technology it emphasizes the material basis of scientific fieldwork joining together the human labor that produced knowledge with the natural world in which those practices were embedded four distinct modes of field practice which were shared by different field science disciplines proliferated during this period surveys lay networks quarries and stations and this book explores the dynamics that underpinned each of them using two diverse case studies to animate each mode of practice as well as the making of the field as a place for science field life combines textured analysis of specific examples of field science on the ground with wider discussion of the commonalities in the practices of a diverse array of field sciences including the earth and physical sciences the life and agricultural sciences and the human sciences by situating science in its regional environmental context field life analyzes the intersection between the cosmopolitan knowledge of science and the experiential knowledge of people living in the field examples of field science in the plains and rockies range widely geological surveys and weather observing networks quarries to uncover dinosaur fossils and archaeological remains and branch agricultural experiment stations and mountain biological field stations

a selected title of the national book foundation and the alfred b sloan foundation s science literature program brilliant terribly stubborn and ill suited to the expectations of the period kate croft has shattered her widowed mother s traditional hopes for her in favor of higher education rejecting domestic pressures she has cleaved out an alternative channel for herself one that

deprioritizes marriage and children more subversive still are the complexities of her sexuality her pursuit of queer relationships in an intensely heteronormative era most notably though she has taken a hammer to her field making debris of its governing premises and challenging the very fundamentals of evolutionary theory spanning nearly sixty years we follow kate from her first introductory biology course at cornell to her receipt of the prize a journey riddled with obstacles kate's scientific medium maize is unglamorous and undervalued in academia her research is so visionary that it alienates her peers who are unable to grasp its complex implications subject to both implicit and explicit sexism kate finds herself perpetually on the defensive struggling to distinguish between those who care for her and those who wish to oppress her a dynamic that traps even her longtime friendships in a state of precarity she struggles to straddle the chasm between the physical field where her corn grows her oasis and the corresponding professional field beleaguered by bias and petty politics

context and situation always matter in both human and animal lives unique insights can be gleaned from conducting scientific studies from within human communities and animal habitats inside science is a novel treatment of this distinctive mode of fieldwork robert e kohler illuminates these resident practices through close analyses of classic studies of trobriand islanders chicago hobos corner boys in boston's north end jane goodall's chimpanzees of the gombe stream reserve and more intensive firsthand observation a preference for generalizing from observed particulars rather than from universal principles and an ultimate framing of their results in narrative form characterize these inside stories from the field resident observing takes place across a range of sciences from anthropology and sociology to primatology wildlife ecology and beyond what makes it special kohler argues is the direct access it affords scientists to the contexts in which their subjects live and act these scientists understand their subjects not by keeping their distance but by living among them and engaging with them in ways large and small this approach also demonstrates how science and everyday life often assumed to be different and separate ways of knowing are in fact overlapping aspects of the human experience this story driven exploration is perfect for historians sociologists and philosophers who want to know how scientists go about making robust knowledge of nature and society

california divvied into its fifty eight counties for example we consider california made up of dancing tectonic plates of watersheds of wildflower gardens maps are enhanced by spirited illustrations of wildlife keys that explain natural phenomena and a clear sighted but reverential text full of character and color a bit larger than life the california field atlas is the ultimate road trip companion and love letter to a place
